

Navigating Milwood's Registration Site

- You will have to register for a Sports Connect account to register
- Select the Challenger division for the program
 - If your player is over the age of 22, you must select the “senior” division
- You do not need to upload a birth certificate
- You will have to “view and accept” the privacy policy
- You will have to “view and accept” the child protection
- You will have to click “view” for the medical release, and then click the “HERE” to open the form. You will have to fill out the PDF, save it and email it to us at: challengerdistrict2@gmail.com Then click “accept”
- You will have to fill out all the other questions, including if your player needs a buddy, and what would you like a buddy to know about your player if they need one
- You will have to click “view and accept” the concussion law
- You will have to click “view and accept” the media release
- For Challenger, we have players throughout all of District 2. For the Residency Eligibility Address part you do not need to upload proof of residency
- For Challenger, since there are so many schools in our district, the school name should automatically populate with “other” in the drop down, and you do not need to attach a school enrollment file
- Click continue once you have answered all questions and accepted all links
- If it asks for parent involvement, you can click “skip”
- If it takes you to Milwood Little League’s fan wear shop, you can skip that. We hope to have our own Challenger fan wear site soon
- It should then show you your player that is registered, and the \$35 league fee. To check out please pay online – there is a nominal service fee for that. If you have the T-Mobile grant, you will have a card number you can input for the credit card method.
